U.S. Steel Report

CLEVELAND, April 6--(AP)-- Fear of a strike and a relaxation of government controls has caused renewed vigor in demand for some steel products, "Steel" magazine says today. The metal-working journal says the strike threat was resulting in mills becoming more cautious about accepting orders for the third quarter of this year. The magazine says that if there is no walkout, the continuation of the demand depends on how well automobiles sell and how much building construction is started. The mills were scheduled to operate at 102 per cent of their rated capacity last week, turning out 2,120,000 net tons of ingots and casting. Production for a comparable week a year ago was 2,047,000 tons. Except for cast iron scrap, which fell, prices for steel and related products remained unchanged -- the magazine's weighed index on finished steel holds at 171.92 and the arithmetic price composite at \$108.32.

BARN MADE FROM OLD PACKING CASES WOULD SAVE FARMERS \$1,500 TO \$3,000

Col. H. L. Armstrong, a superintendent of the Veterans' Land Act, believes he has solved the problem of farmers who are handicapped by a lack of storage space. In place of expensive barns, the ex-Canadian army officer advises using pieces of old automobile packing cases, bolted together to form a triangular prefabricated unit that can be taken apart at will, moved to a new location and re-erected. As no skilled help, nor large timbers are needed to erect the "barn," farmers can save between \$1,500 and \$3,000 by his plan. Col.
