Hello, I hope everyone is enjoying the activities of Carnival Week and looking forward to the events yet to come.

I would like to point out that the material included in this weekly article is not all that is available to students in the way of bursaries and so on. The ones printed each week are those which pertain to the majority of students.

There is only one day left to apply for the two following bursaries:

Bernardine Hall Bursary — Deadline is February 3.

This bursary, first established last year, is once again available to Junior or Senior female students living in residence for two years. Students must have an average of 70% or more and write an essay on their participation in and contribution to residence life over the years. Applications (available in Student Services) will be judged by the Scholarship Committee and two people from Guidance Services.

U.P.E.I. Memorial Bursary Fund — Deadline February 3

Several awards ranging from \$125 to \$300 are available for the second semester. Full-time students in any year may apply. One of the major requirements to be considered will be need. Application forms available in Student Services or Registrars' Office.

A reminder of the deadlines for the following previously advertised bursaries and scholarships:

Tourism Industry — February 18

Rotary Foundation Scholarships '85-86 — March 1, 1984

To students planning to pursue graduate studies in '84-85, these two scholarships may be of interest: (Note that straight A marks is the major consideration.)

MacKenzie King Travelling Scholarships — February 15

For students who plan to attend a university in the United States or the United Kingdom, in post-graduate studies in the field of International or Industrial Relations (including the international or industrial aspects of Law, History, Politics, or Economics).

MacKenzie King Open Scholarships — February 15

Open to graduates for full-time post-graduate studies in Canada or elsewhere and in any field. Awards will be determined on the basis of academic achievement, personal qualities, and demonstrated aptitudes.

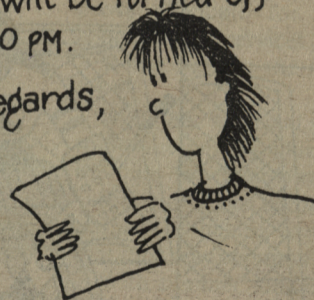

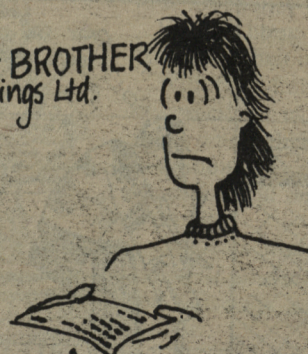
