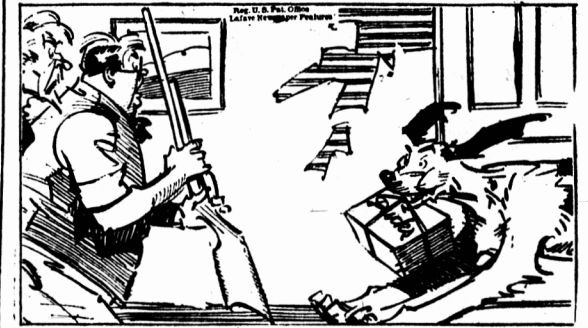

TOKYO, Dec. 18—(AP)—

Airmail from 16 nations including Canada pours into war-torn Korea at the rate of 11 tons a day. The outgoing mail averages five tons a day. An international exchange office has been set up to sort and route the mail to and from the United Nations forces.

LONDON, Dec. 18—(Reuters)—

Royal Navy aircraft operating from the aircraft carrier Theseus have kept up an almost continuous hammering of Communist forces and supply lines in North Korea during the last 10 days. The Admiralty announced today. Pilots and observers had been flying at a rate "probably unsurpassed in carrier operations anywhere," the announcement said.
