NEW YORK

NEW YORK (AP)—The stock market Tuesday ended with its seventh straight daily loss. Trading was heavy.

Volume was 9,830,000 shares compared with 8,690,000 Monday, was the largest since May 17 when 9,970,000 shares changed hands.

The Dow Jones industrial average lost 1.89 to 79.14.

"The type of erratic trading we saw today often occurs at important turning points," said Newton D. Zinder, market analyst for E. F. Hutton and Co.

Glamour stocks among the color televisions, other electronics, photography, office equipments and the like were among the pacemakers, both up and down. Airlines were clobbered.

Magnavox, which has been written up recently, was the most active stock, rising 2% to \$23.00 on 275,000 shares. One block of 150,000 shares of Magnavox was traded at a fractional gain.

General Dynamics was bought on blocks of 49,600 shares, 50,000 and 100,000. It rose 1/4 to 41 1/4 on 248,100 shares.

Transworld Airlines sank 5% to 67 1/2. Pan American World Airways lost 4 1/2. American and United Airlines 2% each. Northwest Airlines 4, Braniff 5 and Western 2 1/2.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks lost 4 at 283.7. Of 1,425 issues traded, 457 declined and 524 advanced. Losses for the year totalled 499. There were no highs.

Eight of the 15 most active stocks rose, six fell and American Telephone was unchanged. Canadian stocks were mixed.

Alcan and Canadian Pacific lost 1/4. Hudson Bay Mining and Walker Gooderham 1/4 and Dome Mines 3/4. On the plus side were Distillers Seagrams, up 1/4, Granby Mining up 1/4 and International Nickel up 1/4.

Prices also declined on the American exchange. Scurry Rainbow Oil lost 1 1/2. Preston Fargo Oil 3-1/2. Canadian Javelin 1/4 and Canadian Marconi 1/4.

MONTREAL

MONTREAL (CP)—The market was off again Tuesday. Declines outnumbered advances 123 to 40 on the two Montreal boards, and 74 to 20 on the senior list.

Of 135 issues traded on the Montreal exchange, 41 ended unchanged.

Volume leader for the day was Alcan, which lost 1/4 at 30 1/2. Du Pont and Molson A were off 1/4 at 32 1/2 and 16 1/2. Massey-Ferguson and CPR lost 1/4 each at 30 1/2 and 56 1/2.

Quebec Telephone was up 1/4 at 19 1/2. Nova Scotia Light and Quebec Natural Gas were unchanged at 11 and 12 1/2. Two pipe lines, Interprovincial and Trans-Canada, dipped 1/4 at 75 and 30.

Banks were weak. Nova Scotia hit a low of 65. off 1/4 while Provincial dropped one point and Royal 1/4 to 44 and 67 1/2. Dominion Foundries slid 1/4 points to 21 1/2 in senior steels.

Five papers hit lows. Abitibi Consolidated, Domtar, MacMillan-Bloedel and Price Bros. None took serious losses.

Home Oil A closed 1/4 down at 29 1/2. The B 1/4 at 22. B-A Oil touched 29 1/2, off 1/4. On the Canadian Exchange Peace River Mining jumped \$1.60 to \$9.00.

Industrial volume was 162,200 shares and mines and oils 638,300 shares, lowest since Aug. 1. In the latter case, Monday's comparable figures are 142,300 and 822,100.

On index, industrials were off 0.62 at 147.35; banks 0.34 at 110.15; papers 0.27 at 107.91; utilities advanced 0.32 at 132.51. The composite index showed 0.43 lower at 141.02.

TORONTO

TORONTO (CP)—An attempted late rally Tuesday fizzled, sending prices on the Toronto Stock Exchange into their seventh consecutive day of decline.

The industrial index, closed at 148.46, down 35. It had been as low as 148.07 at noon. As a result of the slump 121 issues fell to 1966 lows. Declines outnumbered gains 329 to 118 with 217 issues unchanged.

Although volume was higher than Monday's turnover, brokers say there appears to be no panic selling. Only 2,896,000 shares changed hands compared with 2,487,000 Monday.

Scotia 1 to 65 and Royal Bank 3/4 to 67 1/2. Western oils dropped 7/16 to a low of 99.35. Scurry Rainbow slid 2 1/4 to 24 1/2 and Pacific Petroleum 1/4 to 9 1/2. In base metals Cominco retreated 1/4 to a low of 35 1/2 while Noranda gained 1/4 to 49 and Inco 1/4 to 82 1/2. On index, golds were off 2.65 to 174.29, base metals 65 to 87.38 and the TSE 42 to 141.55.
