OTTAWA (CP) - Crude oil production in July was 26,059,586 barrels, a gain of almost five per cent from the 24,942,186 barrels produced in July of last year, the Dominion Bureau of Statistics reported. July output of natural gas was up 4.4 per cent over the previous July at 99,453,559,000 cubic feet.

OTTAWA (CP) - October production of instant skim milk powder was 3,440,681 pounds for a gain of about three per cent from 3,338,076 in the same month of 1964, the Dominion Bureau of Statistics reported. Output for the first 10 months was 28,490,302 pounds, off slightly from 28,690,092 pounds in the same period last year.
