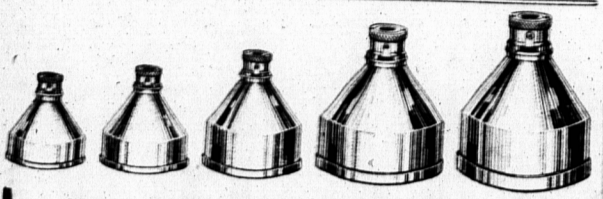

Modern Spring Suspension

(BY HARRY PORTER.)
 The spring suspension on automobiles has changed considerably during the last few years. Automobile manufacturers have been convinced that the lines and grace of a car are but minor features to be considered, as far as engineering is concerned. A good motor clutch transmission and differential of course are essential, but the life of the whole life of these conspicuous parts is dependent entirely upon the spring of the car.
 Direct concussion, incessantly delivered to the differential through the rear wheels, ultimately destroys it.
 If one could but imagine the number of shocks a car received on a hundred mile trip one would receive a shock as sudden and destructive as the sum of ten thousand shocks therefore, perhaps the greatest feature to consider in an automobile is the springs.
 We started with the full elliptic, then followed 3/4 elliptic rear and cantilever front. Then cantilever rear and front, and in recent years transverse cantilever rear with hotchkiss drive. All these changes were made to eliminate shock to the running gear and lengthen the life of the car as much as possible.
 Engineers were confronted with a problem in the spring suspension of a light car of short wheelbase. This car is more susceptible to shocks than a large car of longer wheelbase. Many types of springs were tried but none proved any more successful in absorbing shocks than another, until an engineer of no mean ability perfected the "Triplex Springs" now used on the light Overland car.
 This design of spring accomplished the long desired effect. It really did absorb shocks. Also it afforded 130 inches of spring base to the car of 100 inches wheelbase enabling the car to ride similar to a car of long wheelbase—even better.
 The reason for this being that the front wheels are not pushed forward as in an ordinary spring suspension. By inspecting the front springs of a light Overland it can readily be seen that the springs are attached to the chassis ahead of the front wheels and at one point only and then point towards the rear separating from the central point at about thirty degrees angle where each spring is attached to the front axle with a radius spring for thrust.
 This means then that when the front wheel hits against a large stone or hole in the road the wheel simply raises up from the central point of suspension and absolutely no shock is delivered to the chassis or running gear. The system is more easily understood when explained in a very everyday manner. If you load a wheelbarrow with sand and then try to wheel it up over a curb stone by pushing it you would find that it is an impossible task, but if you turned the wheelbarrow

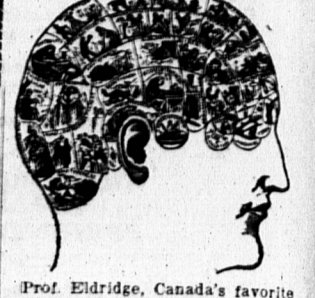
