### Completion Of 8 Arrows Sought

TORONTO (CP) — A protest meeting of an expected 10,000 aircraft workers here Thursday will hear demands that \$100,000,000 compensation to be paid their former employers be used to complete eight CF-105 Arrow interceptors.

The meeting was called by the International Association of Machinists (I.A.M.), bargaining agent for most of the employees of Avro Aircraft Limited and Orenda Engines Limited who were dismissed last Friday when the federal government cancelled its order for the jet plane.

Union spokesmen said Tuesday they will demand at the meeting that the \$100,000,000 the federal government must pay companies affected by its decision be used to complete eight planes in various stages of construction at the Avro plant.

However, George Schollie of Montreal, Canadian vice-president of the machinists, and a member of a union delegation in Ottawa to see cabinet ministers, said such a proposal is "pretty senseless."

Other developments Tuesday included: Sources at A. V. Roe Canada Limited, parent of the two companies, and manufacturing sources were reported as saying that for about \$100,000,000 the 37 Arrows called for in the cancelled contract could have been completed.

Premier Frost announced he has called a meeting of manufacturers' representatives for consultations with the federal government on the fate of the Avro plant.
