A LARGE HARVEST CONFIDENTLY ANTICIPATED—THE MCCARTHY MURDER—SOURIS COAL LANDS—RAILWAY EXTENSION.

It is proposed to pave Main Street, Winnipeg, at a cost of \$18,728.

A Canada Methodist church, to cost \$1,200, is being erected near Portage la Prairie.

The disease known as pink-eye is reported to have made its appearance in Winnipeg.

It is proposed to erect city buildings in Winnipeg at a cost of \$80,000. A public hall to seat 1,200 people and 40 rooms for civic offices, will be provided.

Reports regarding the condition of the crops from the east and south for thirty miles around Winnipeg are highly favorable. It is stated that they never looked better than at present, and that with a fair amount of rain the harvest this year will be the most abundant that Manitoba has known for a number of years past.

It is intended to lay ten miles of track on the Canada Pacific to equal the record of the Central Pacific, which, however is not as good a performance as the laying of six miles on the Canadian Pacific, because extensive preparations had been made to accomplish the feat on the Central Pacific, iron being laid at every point in advance.

Rev. Mr. Jukes, who has just returned from the Beautiful Plains district, reports having seen two bears last week. One was a cinnamon, about the size of a Newfoundland dog, and the other black and much larger—probably the size of a full-grown ox. Several parties report having seen bears on the Beautiful Plains, and a number of attempts have been made to shoot them but so far without success.

The man Stephenson, who was arrested for disclosing facts connected with the McCarthy murder, part of which were read from a pack of cards, has been brought to Regina. This man describes how the crime was committed and informs the officers where certain articles belonging to the old man can be found; he also tells the last words uttered by McCarthy, and how forcibly the first blows took effect. Beyond a doubt, if not the perpetrator of the terrible deed he was present when it was being executed.

General Superintendent Egan, of the Canada Pacific, says that shortly after leaving Calgary, rock-cutting in the foot-hills will commence, and it is believed that a half-mile tunnel will have to be bored ere reaching the summit. The tracklayers expect to reach Calgary the 10th of August, if not earlier. Telegraphic construction also keeps abreast of the tracklaying. Mr. Egan describes the country where tracklaying is now going on as a fine rolling prairie, and from it the first view of the Rockies is had. The crops everywhere look well, and with some rain just now an unusually abundant harvest may be looked for.

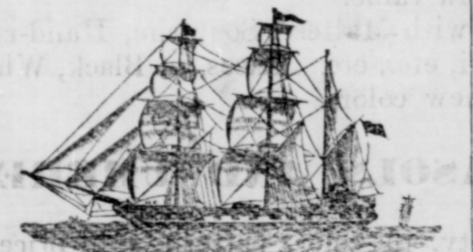

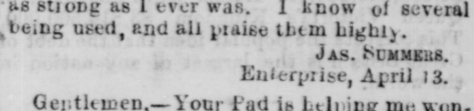

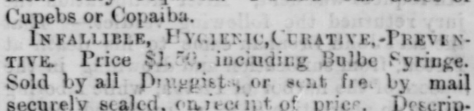
