Supplying Arctic Bases Will Require About 50 Ships

By IAN DONALDSON Canadian Press Staff Writer HALIFAX (CP)-Canadian and United States admirals met here last week to map plans for the trucky job of moving 500,000 tons of supplies to northern outposts while Arctic weather is favorable. Rear-Admiral E. T. Eller, commander of the U.S. Navy's Task Force Six, met with Rear-Admiral Hugh F. Pullen, chief of the Canadian Atlantic Fleet. They discussed this year's resupply operations to Dis- tinct Early Warning line installations and armed forces bases on Baffin Island, Greenland and La-

brood. About 50 ships - Mostly Navy - will take part in three-months operation, cut few weeks in some areas by weather. More than 2,000 Army troops, under Maj. - E. M. Houseman of the Atlantic Transportation Terminal Command, will "stevedore" the piles. Admiral Eller said at a press conference Canadian participation this year has been stepped up with the transport department taking over re-supply Foxe Basin west of Baffin land. Canadian naval divers accompany U.S. ships to sur- landing beaches and keep them clear, he said. SUPPLY PORT Halifax will serve as a main supply port for the ships, which carry food, mechanical equipment and oil to the scattered bases. The navy's wireless communication system here will be the fleet with headquarters in New York.
