The bill was introduced by Premier Smallwood. The law becomes effective Feb. 1.

At least 12 stores remained closed Monday but all are apparently awaiting details of the latest legislation before deciding whether to open next Saturday. Monday was the closing day adopted by downtown merchants this summer.
