Brainpower Loss To U.S. Feared

OTTAWA (CP)—Canada may lose more of its scientific brainpower to the United States as a result of the success of the American space program. This fear was expressed Wednesday by spokesmen for the Professional Institute of the Public Service of Canada, which represents some 5,600 scientific and professional workers employed by the federal government. Officials of the Chemical Institute of Canada and the Canadian Council of Professional Engineers also said private industry stands to lose additional basic research scientists attracted to the U.S. mainly by the challenge of space travel. The National Research Council and the Defence Research Board, the two federal government agencies engaged in space research, said the new driving force for space scientists in the U.S. has not yet been felt by these two government bodies. However, Dr. E. W. R. Steacie, president of N.R.C., "we can't say what will happen in the future." The National Aeronautics and Space Administration in the U.S. now is in the process of recruiting 2,000 additional scientists and engineers. The agency already has a staff of 6,000.

He earned his parachutist's wings last week at the Canadian Joint Air Training Centre at Rivers, Man.
