### Proper Work Week On Two Nfld. Projects

OTTAWA (CP) — Labor Minister Gregg said Tuesday a departmental investigator has found that employees are not being worked beyond the authorized work week on two projects at La Scie, Nfld.

He informed the Commons that the official also has given a "negative" report on another complaint that local employees are being paid less than workers from the mainland.

Mr. Gregg was replying to a question last month by Thomas Barnett (CCF — Comox-Alberni), who had referred to reports that employees at the La Scie projects were being worked 60 hours a week with no overtime and that local men received less pay than those from outside Newfoundland.

### Gasoline Up Half-Cent Gal.

MONTREAL (CP) — Canadian Petrofina Ltd. Tuesday announced a half-cent a gallon increase in its gasoline and furnace oil prices and an increase of 7-10 of a cent a gallon in its diesel oil price. The increases become effective immediately.

This brings the price of Fina gas to 44.9 cents for the regular grade and 46.9 cents for the premium grade. Diesel oil prices vary according to retailer.

The increases are similar to those announced earlier Tuesday by Imperial Oil Limited for Quebec, the Maritimes and Newfoundland.
