and feeding your plants and the portable part of your garden will be a pleasant adventure. A wide variety of plants can be grown in this fashion to lend that same pleasant change that occurs when you rearrange your furniture indoors.

There are many varieties of plants suitable for a portable garden... Fuschias, Geraniums in all colors, Hydrangeas and several annuals such as Petunia, Balsam and Nasturtium.

Primroses are blooming in soft yellow with an orange eye, dark crimson and a lovely pinkish mauve. These were gifts from a gardener friend from a neighboring province and the same friend who brought the lovely Forsythia to this garden several springs ago.

In 1785 William Cowper wrote of the Primrose in the English lane. And lanes in which the primrose ere her time Peeps through the moss that clothes the hawthorn root.

Lovely ferns are in the wood and in many varieties, also they are seen in some gardens where the gardener has taken a short time to gather them in the shady places and plant them for permanent beauty at little cost.

A very pleasant morning was spent at "The Cotton Memorial Nursery" this week and the moment you drive by the large sign you notice the luxuriant growth of all the shrubs and trees. It is hard to believe that the lovely garden has been made in three years and has been instrumental in making hundreds of gardens on this island by the distribution of healthy shrubs and plants.

It is also an experimental nursery to determine the hardiness of tender shrubs and trees for our climate, and many of these have proved to be suitable for the Island gardens. The superintendent points with pride to the wistaria covered with pendulous trusses of lilac-coloured flowers on this lovely vine that has such beautiful foliage.

Japanese cherry trees will soon

be in blossom and they are one of the loveliest of trees. Visitors to Washington in April are always enthusiastic about the great cherry blossom display around the basin and in the area adjoining the Jefferson Memorial. In fact, this great outburst of spring bloom has come to be synonymous with spring activities in the capital.

Garden enthusiasts who have seen these trees are always anxious to plant them, and when these trees are placed in an appropriate setting, they are particularly notable, both in flower and in foliage.

I saw all these lovely bulbs at the Nursery that morning and Muscari with the beautiful blue spikes, long-lasting and looking so well with the water lily tulip and all the early varieties. The hyacinths in all colors, fragrant and lovely.

Two beautiful early shrubs were blooming... spirea arguta with lovely graceful branches covered with creamy white blooms, this is a hardy shrub for our gardens. Cydonia japonica was also blooming with scarlet flowers reminding one of small single roses.

Tree Peonies are grown in this nursery and where the location is sunny and soil is well drained they do well. They are so lovely with immense blooms suggestive of Chinese silk and with rich colors.
