al needs of the students and to suggest the direction in which U.P.E.I. should proceed in the future.

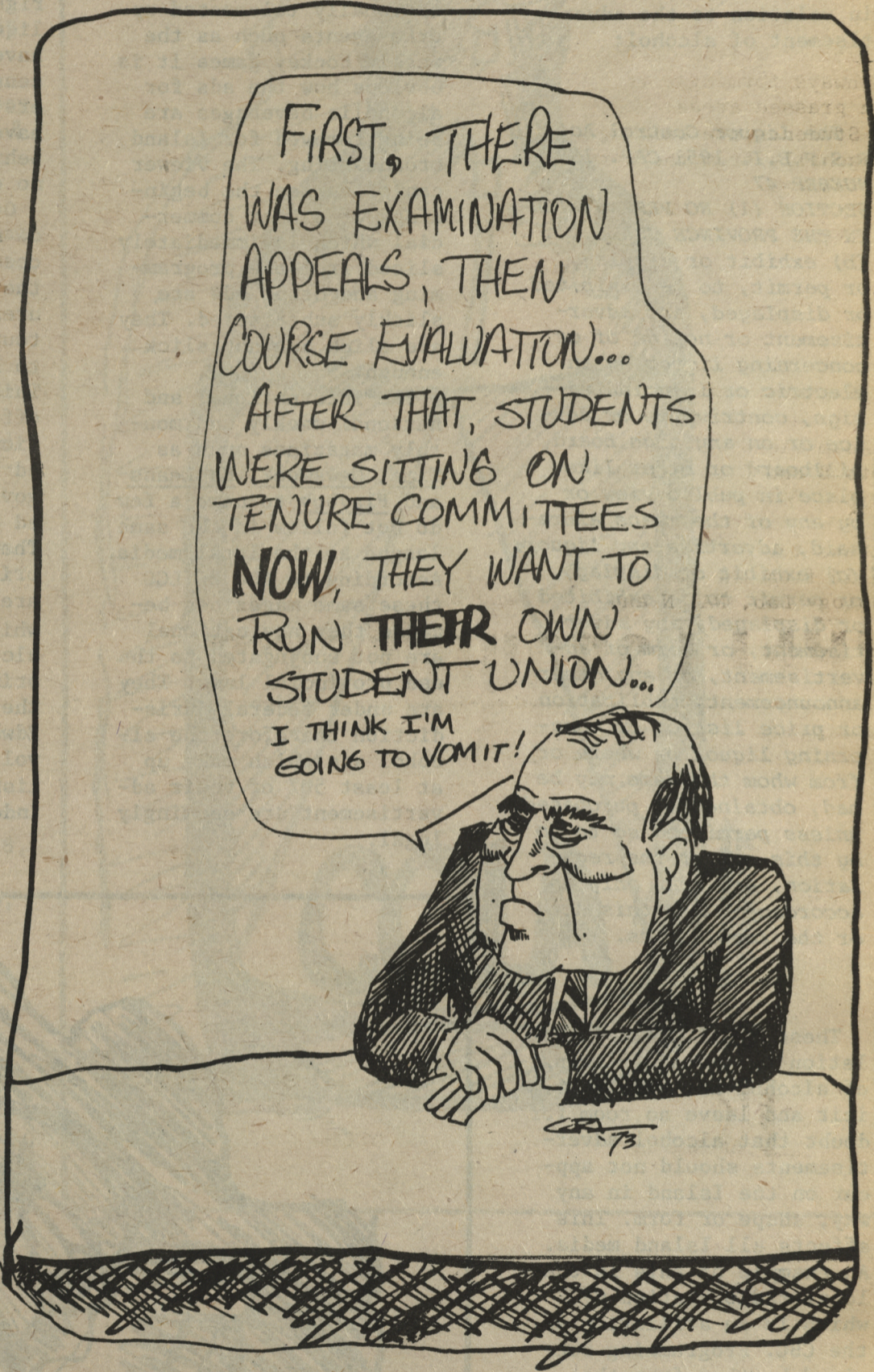
