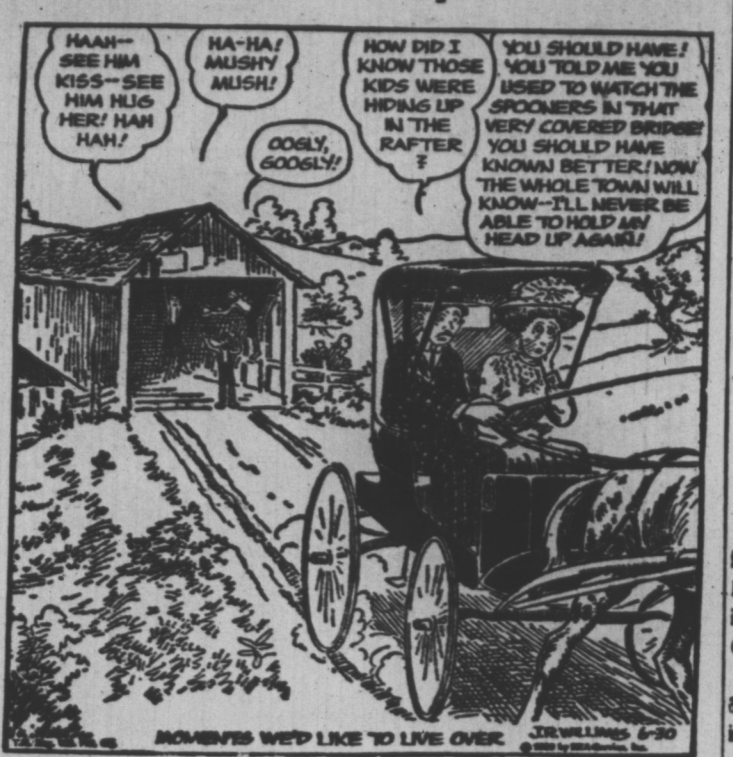

The attention of Trailer Coach Owners and Occupants in Suburbs Charlottetown, Southport, Incorporated Villages, Trans-Canada Highway Area, Wilmot, Sherbrooke, and Bunbury School Districts, is directed to Part Eleven (11) Section 62, Sub-sections (1), (2) and (3) of The Town Planning Act Regulations which read as follows:

22. (1) No person shall use any trailer coach for living or sleeping quarters, or for business purposes or for any other purpose unless such trailer coach is located within the boundaries of a licensed trailer court.

(2) The Minister may issue a temporary permit to locate a trailer coach on the property of a property owner to any person who is a private guest of such owner.

(3) Such permit shall be valid for not more than thirty days and said permit shall be posted on or beside such trailer coach.

The above Regulations will be strictly enforced seven days from the publication of this notice.

The Responsibility of protecting his workmen lies with the employer and heavy penalties will be levied upon any employer who carries on operations and fails to report to this Board.

NOTICE TO WORKMEN

It is important for you to know whether or not you are covered under the Workmen's Compensation Act. Ask your Employer when hiring on with him if he is registered with the Board.

If there are three or more workmen at the same time employed in an Industry within the Scope of the Act, it is compulsory for the Employer to Register with the Board.
