COST OF PRODUCING TOBACCO IN ONTARIO

TORONTO, June 8.—Careful records of the expenditure involved in producing a crop of tobacco have been kept at the Harrow Tobacco Station, where it was found that the total cost of growing six acres of Burley in 1921 was \$1,322.91, or \$220.49 per acre.

The cost of producing four acres of flue-cured tobacco totalled \$1,183.71 or \$293.92 per acre, the cost of producing one pound of flue-cured tobacco being 50.218.

Fixed charges in either case included: Grower's license, \$2; rent chimney at \$1.50 per acre and use of land at \$10 per acre; use of manuring barn and lath per acre, \$10.
