MONTREAL (CP) - The United States dollar in terms of Canadian funds was up 3-32 at \$1.07 21-32. Pound sterling was up 3-16 at \$3.00 1/2.

NEW YORK

NEW YORK AP - The stock market mounted a brisk rally Thursday with airlines, aerospace issues and electronics advancing. Trading was active. Volume increased to 6,070,000 shares from 5,590,000 Wednesday, and was the largest since Feb. 10 when 7,200,000 shares changed hands.

MONTREAL

MONTREAL (CP) - The market was generally up but utilities, papers and machinery issues were off in fairly light trading Thursday on the Montreal and Canadian Stock Exchanges. Industrial volume was 188,200 shares and mites 1,267,100. The composite index dropped 0.3 to 161.0. Industrials were up 0.3 to 165.8. Dominion Textile added 1/4 to 37 1/2 and Moore Corp. 1/2 to 61. Dominion Glass was up 1/2 to 16 1/2.
