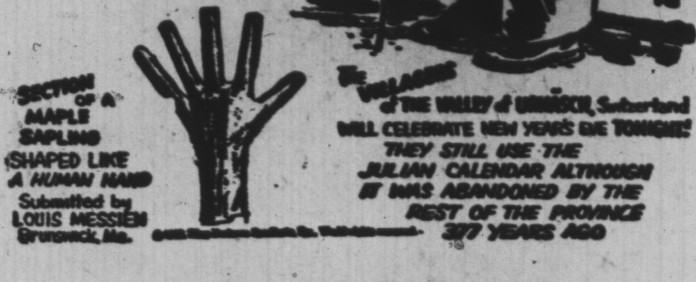

Canada Asks U.S. To Steer Europe To Freer World Trade

OTTAWA (CP) — The United States, at Canada's persuasion, may act as doctor in attempts to heal Europe's split personality. Canadian sources said Wednesday the development by two countries of a common approach to the problems of European integration was one of the most significant decisions reached at this week's meeting here of the joint Canada-U.S. cabinet committee on trade and economic affairs. They anticipate that in the next few months the U.S. will take more vigorous action in attempts to reconcile the divergent trade views represented by Britain and France and try to steer Europe towards freer world trade.

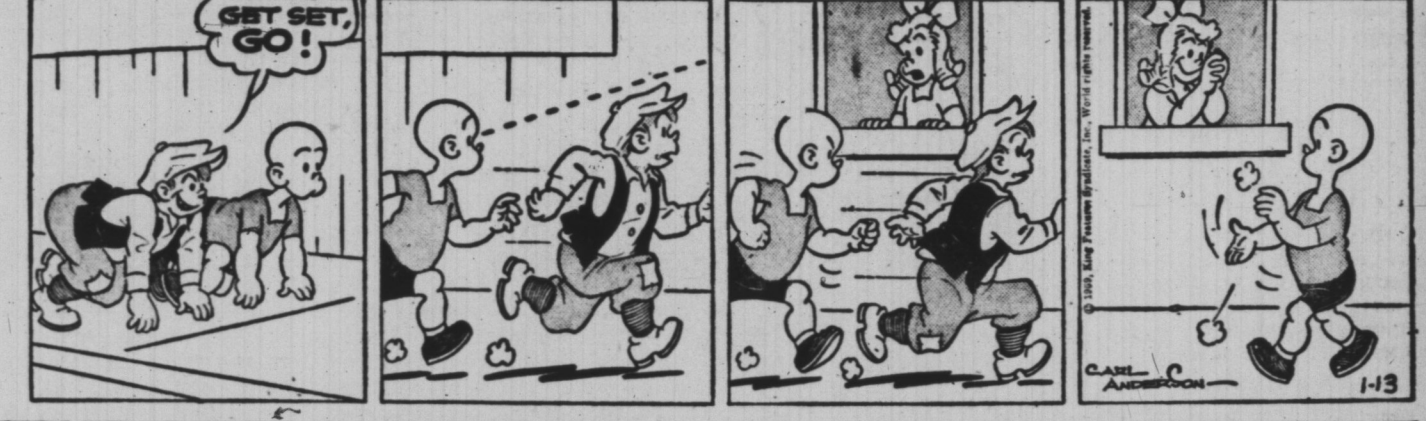
