at which point he had a crucial decision to make in the defense. There was a chance East had the eight of spades, in which case leading the thirteenth heart would defeat the contract by inducing East to trump with the eight.

If, though, East lacked the spade eight, the heart lead might lose the contract by permitting dummy to trump with the seven as South shed a loser. West decided there was less chance on the bidding that East had the crucial eight than that South had a side loser, and led the jack of spades.

Declarer rattled off six trump tricks in succession, on the last of which West had to choose a discard from Q-7-6 of diamonds and K-9 of clubs. The dilemma faced by West would have been well-nigh insoluble but for the highly significant discard which East with his miserable hand had made on the previous three trump leads. They consisted of the two, three, five of diamonds.

The four of diamonds was unaccounted for! South must have it. East could not have the four since he would have played it instead of the five. Likewise, judging again from East's discards declarer must have also both the ace and king of diamonds.

West's problem was solved. South had started with six spades, three hearts and three diamonds. He could not have more than one club. So West threw the nine of clubs, blanking his king, and South went down to defeat.
