Already her five children and relatives living in the United States and Canada are planning a family reunion at her present home to commemorate the occasion on that date.

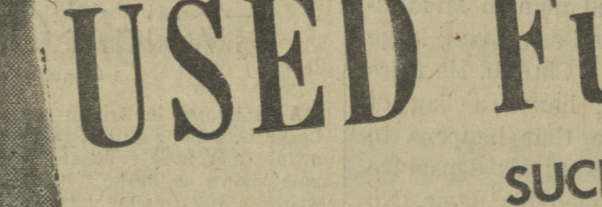
