**FREE TRADE BRITAIN'S DISTRESS**  
LONDON, Feb. 23. — James Caird, M.P., and another hearing before the House of Commons to-day before the Committee on the subject of the unemployed. He said that the distress was so widespread that a grant of £2,500,000 would only be a drop in the bucket of the unemployed throughout the country for six weeks.



Canadian Artisan to Canadian Farmer—And they've got that blessed thing called Free Trade over there, haven't they?

**A HEAVY DILL OF DAMAGES.**

Sir Richard's calculation of the "injury" done to Canada by the protective policy in trade, is analogous to Mr. Sumner's estimate of the "consequential damages" done to United States commerce by the rebel cruiser Alabama. The claim of \$360,000,000 was seriously advanced before the Geneva conference on that question. When simmered down, the arbitrators allowed \$15,000,000 as the full measure of the damage. But after satisfying every claim that could possibly be trumped up, there is a balance of nine millions left in the Treasury at Washington, with no one asking for any portion of it.

Sir Richard declared at Baymouthe the other day that "Canada has paid six hundred million dollars for the experience of protection," meaning, we suppose, that she is out of pocket that much by working for herself rather than have all sorts of foreigners working for her. Does any one believe Sir Richard? One proof of the contrary is that Canada's credit is twelve per cent. higher in the money markets now than it was while the bold Blue Bird Knight was at the financial helm. The Postal Savings today are some twenty millions more than when his Government was in power. In 1878, the last year of Sir Richard's reign, the Dominion had 6,000 miles of railway. It has now 15,000 miles of railway—the greatest ratio of increase in any country in the world. In 1878, the burden of sea-going ships entered and cleared at Canadian ports was 4,684,381 tons. This was under a free trade policy, calculated to encourage foreign trade. In 1892, under a protective policy, calculated also to encourage foreign trade, the burden of sea-going ships entered and cleared at Canadian ports was 12,752,974 tons. In 1878, under Free Trade, the tonnage of vessels sailing between ports in our province and the ports of another or of the same province was 1,371,731 tons. In 1892 the tonnage of the same class of vessels had grown to 25,109,925. It is provided that no vessel under protection.

A day or two Sir Richard had the opportunity to tell a Bow newspaper in London that Canada had paid six hundred millions or the expense of protection. If Canada had to pay this amount of money, she has been far better off to let her protection than she was in 1878, when Sir Richard, as Finance Minister, had to go upon his knees to his English money lenders for loans amounting to \$8,000,000 of the dollar of our currency, and when he was forced to confess that every dollar that had been borrowed by his predecessors had been applied with the most scrupulous regard to the public advantage. To Sir Richard's tale at an exaggerated and denying the good, is a in great measure the undoing of the Brits.—London Free Press.
