

X-Rated Hypnotist Tony Lee: Chair Humping No Longer Restricted to Cadre office

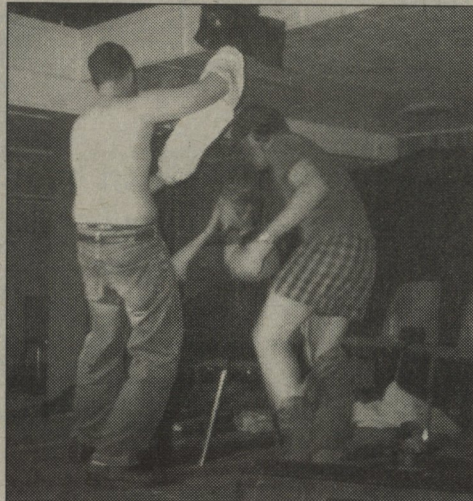

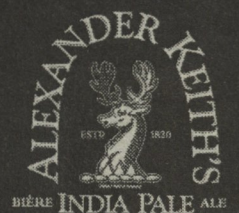
