



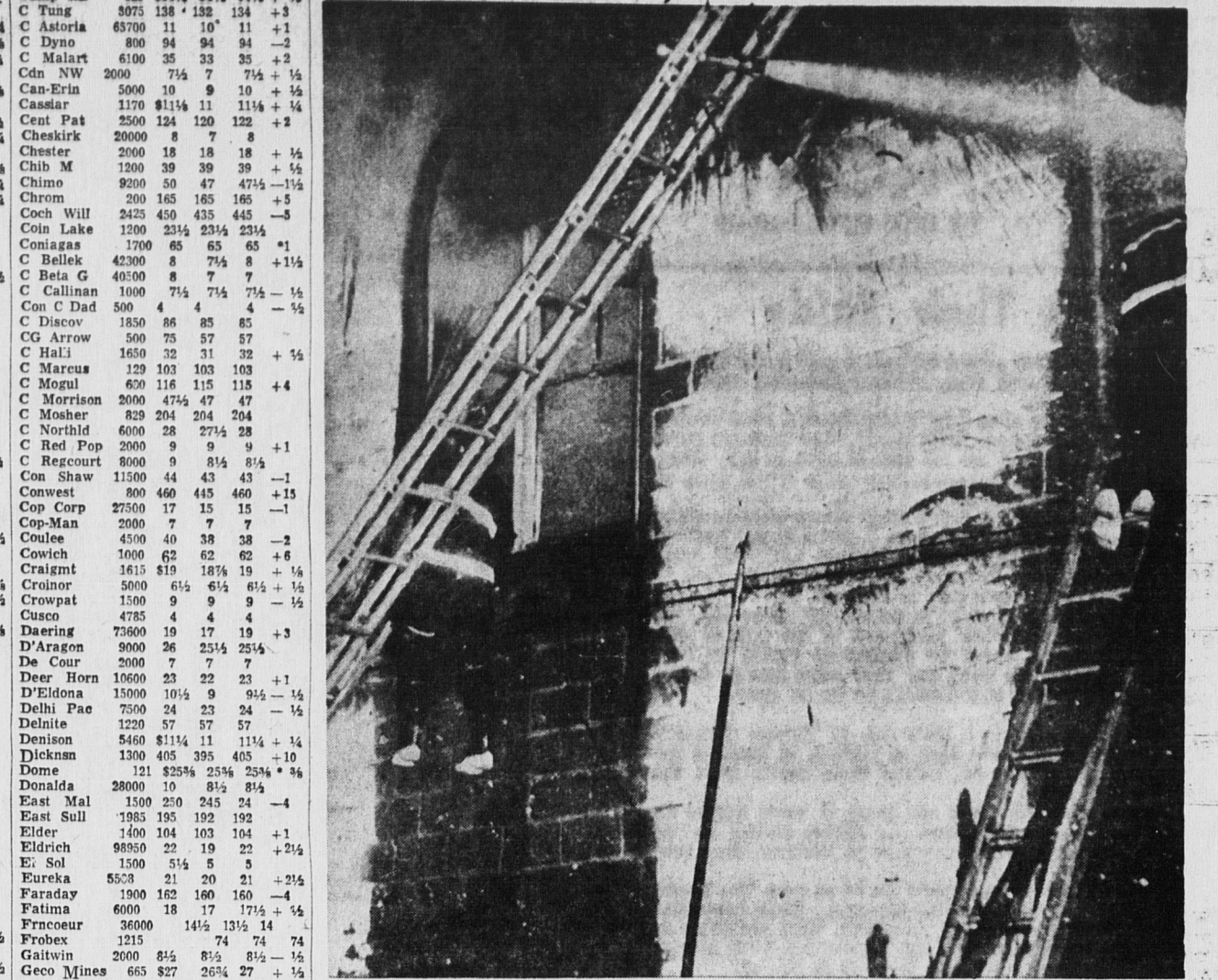
MOSES GETS HUG

By HAROLD MORRISON WASHINGTON (CP) - Supported by Canada, a U.S. assault on European Common Market farm restrictions likely will move into high gear shortly as the U.S. prepares the way for major tariff negotiations now planned for the spring of 1964.

WHEAT BUT CANADIAN WHEAT AS WELL

Canadian officials said they are co-operating fully with the U.S. in realizing that only the U.S. has the power-through Kennedy's new tariff-making authority-to force the Common Market to adopt more liberal policies.

HOWEVER, CANADA IS PREPARED TO DEMAND COMPENSATION FOR THE TRADE BLOC UNDER THE GENERAL AGREEMENT ON TARIFFS AND TRADE

However, Canada is prepared to demand compensation for the trade bloc under the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade if the European powers breach specific tariff pledges. A Canadian informant said it is rather ironic that for a long time the U.S. reacted complacently to warnings and alarms raised by Canada on Common Market trends towards restrictions.

THESE OFFICIALS SAID PRESIDENT KENNEDY HAS ALREADY MADE HIS POSITION CLEAR IN A PRIVATE MESSAGE TO THE COMMON MARKET LEADERS

These officials said President Kennedy has already made his position clear in a private message to the Common Market leaders, warning that "serious consequences" would follow if the farm curbs aren't modified.

ACTION TO REDUCE THE COMMON MARKET TARIFF ON POULTRY IS EXPECTED AT BRUSSELS NEXT WEEK

Officials here said the reduction may not be as large as the U.S. government wants but negotiators will maintain pressure to chip away at the restrictions which threaten to eliminate the \$500,000-a-year U.S. poultry market in Europe.

FOLLOWING POULTRY NEGOTIATIONS THE COMMON MARKET HAS AGREED TO NEGOTIATE WITH CANADA AND THE U.S. ON NEW EUROPEAN WHEAT TARIFFS

Following poultry negotiations the Common Market has agreed to negotiate with Canada and the U.S. on new European wheat tariffs. Agriculture Secretary Orville Freeman stated last week that the Common Market admits the high wheat support of some \$3.10 a bushel, the European market will be crippled and eventually eliminated not only for U.S.
