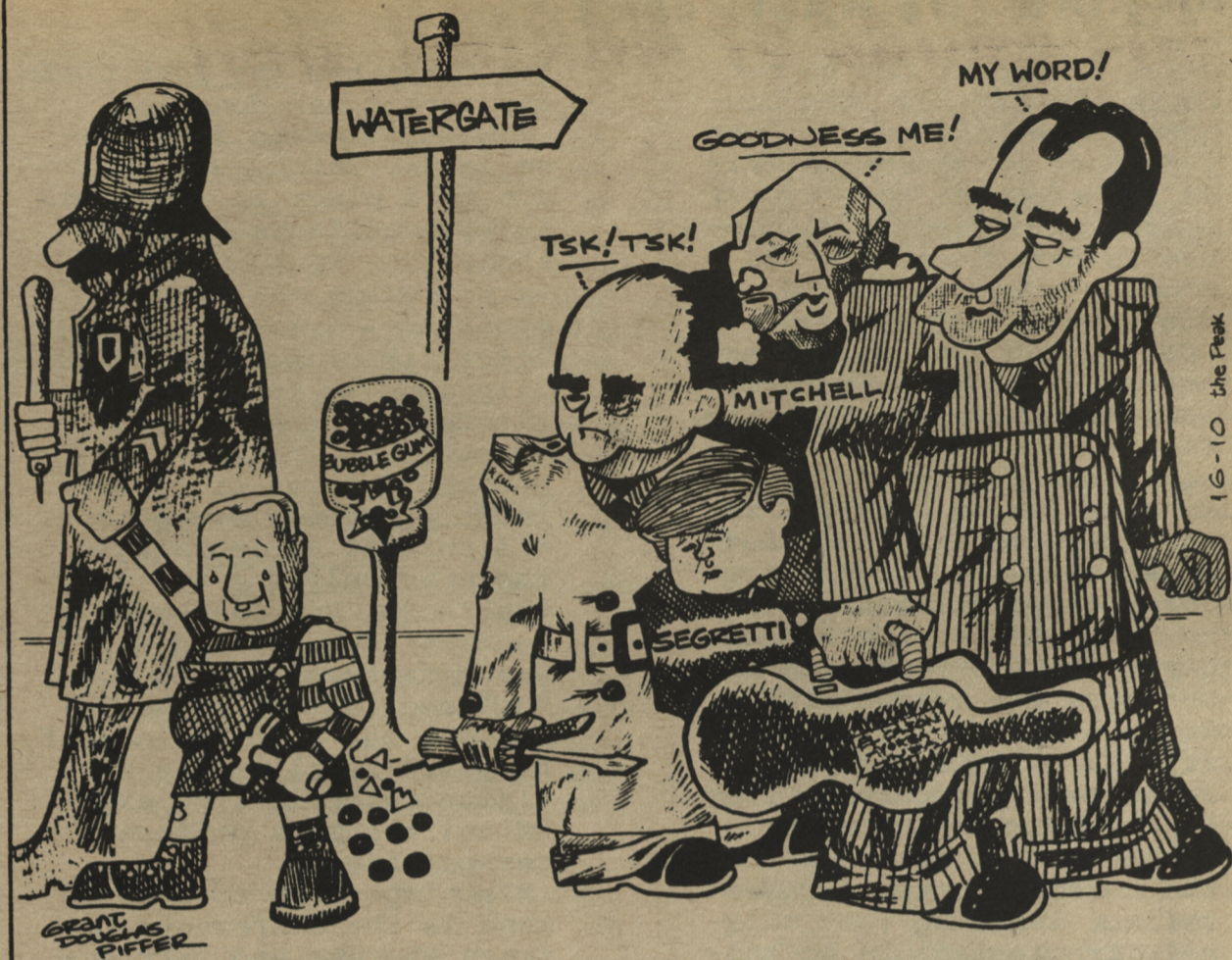
REWARD: For Information Leading to the Whereabouts of the Missing Council & Senate Members.
