This 1970 Academy Award-winning documentary features

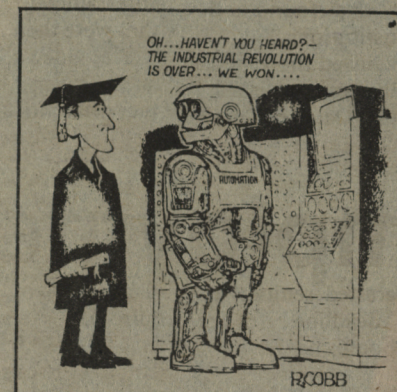
