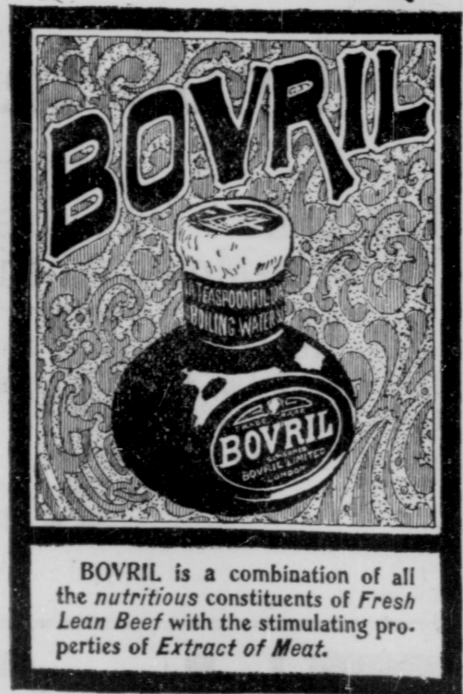

**KILLED BY A TRAIN.**

Sad Death of Alexander Reeves, of East Milton, Mass

Shortly before 6 o'clock last evening people at South Boston station of the New York, New Haven and Hartford railroad and the hundreds of passers-by on Dover St., near the station, were horrified to see two men struck by the passenger train and hurled a great distance. The men were Alexander S. Reeves and Manuel T. Perry. Reeves was killed outright, and Perry was seriously injured and removed to the hospital.

Reeves was 48 years of age, married, and lived on Squantum St., East Milton, Perry is 47, and lives at 242 Adam St., Dorchester.

The two men were on their way home, and were going to the South Boston Station to take the 5.43 train for Milton. They descended the steps from Dover St., and started to cross the tracks to where they would board their train. Their train was coming, and they hurried to cross, but were struck by the 5.50 inward-bound passenger train, which they evidently did not see.

Reeves was thrown some 50 feet, and when picked up was dead.

Perry was hurled to the side of the track. He received contusions of the right shoulder and internal injuries. He was taken in a brain to the terminal station and from there removed to the city hospital in the police ambulance.

The body of Reeves was taken in charge by an undertaker and removed to the city hospital morgue.

Perry was unconscious when picked up and it was at first impossible to learn the name of his companion. The articles in the latter's pocket were taken to Station 6, and there Lieut. Smith found among them things bearing the name of Mrs. Reeves. Word was sent to her and she called at the station and identified the watch and other property of the dead man.

Medical examiner Draper was notified.—Boston Globe, September 16.
