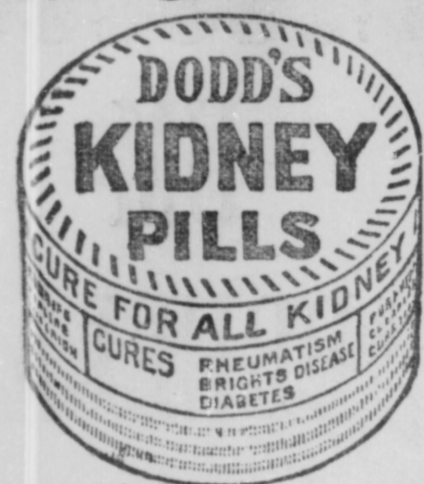

Of Special Interest to our Farmers

FOOD VALUES.

In the course of a recent address Mr. J. J. Ferguson, Smiths Falls, Ont., gave the following as the values of various foods for pigs:

BRAN AND SHORTS, though comparatively high priced, are almost indispensable for feeding brood sows and giving the young pigs a good start and muscle. We have found it profitable to exchange oats for shorts at the elevator, pound and pound.

OATS fed whole to sows or breeding stock in small quantities are our most convenient feed. They are not first-class food for younger stock owing to the very large proportion of hull, and are therefore entirely unfit to be fed to young pigs without first being ground then having the hull removed. Many young pigs are severely injured if not killed outright by the irritation produced by the hulls in the food passages.

PEAS. Our bacon goes to England under the brand "Choicest Canadian Pea Fed Bacon" stamped on every side and package. Under this title it has secured an enviable reputation in contrast to "American Corn Fed." Peameal or cooked peas to the extent of one half the total grain ration is one of our best, if not the best feed, to feed in finishing the bacon hog. Finely-ground pea-meal should not be fed alone owing to its tendency to "pack." Whole peas soaked are first-class as a change of diet.

BARLEY is one of our best all-round hog foods. It is a splendid flesh former for young pigs, and for finishing the hog is regarded most highly by the Danes who have made such a splendid success in this business. It should not be fed to brood sows shortly before or after farrowing, as it seems to be especially active in causing "milk fever" which means death to the litter.

CORN, despite all that has been said against it, is one of our best hog foods if wisely used. Young pigs had better not receive any until older than three months and then in but small quantities. As part of the mixed ration, after this age it gives excellent results, fed either on the cob or ground. Corn and cob meal has been found equal in value, pound for pound, compared with corn-meal, not only because the cob is specially valuable in itself but that it serves the purpose of loosening up the meal ration and making it more easily digested. A few ears of corn per day are a very useful addition to the brood sow's root ration, in cold weather.

BUCKWHEAT.—Since this grain is one of the staple products of this province, you will be pleased to learn that experiments tend to indicate that it may quite safely be used as a partial ration without any injurious effects. A complete meal ration of buckwheat would very probably result in soft bacon.

POTATOES.—Raw potatoes are unprofitable food for hogs. In cooking the starch grains which they contain in such large quantities, are broken up

and rendered more digestible. They are of the few seeds which it will pay to cook.

CORN SILAGE.—This is not a profitable hog food owing to the fact that while the hogs will search out and eat every particle of grain, they will waste the greater part of the fibrous silage which might be better fed to a good dairy cow to produce milk to finally feed the hog.

CLOVER HAY.—Last season a number of pigs at the Central Experimental Farm were fed a small ration of clover hay cut fine and soaked in addition to their grain ration. The result was not very encouraging, and would indicate that there is little to be gained from its use in this way.

SOILING CROPS.—While green peas and oats may be used as a partial substitute where clover will not thrive there is a large amount of labor and waste involved in cutting and feeding in pens and yards.

LUCERNE CLOVER OR ALFALFA.—Where these will thrive they answer the purpose admirably, producing large quantities of nutritious fodder if cut before becoming woody. Rape has also been tried with very fair success.

RAW VS. COOKED FEED. With the different grain foods it is more than doubtful if there is a sufficient increase in value to repay the labor and fuel involved in cooking. The weight of evidence shows there is no profit in the operation. The case of potatoes and roots for young stock are practically the only ones in which there is an equivalent return. But it will be found profitable to soak all meal feed, at least twelve hours. Two feed barrels are necessary in order to do this. If the soaking can be cheaply done by hot water so much the better.
