That Body Of Yours

Cancer of the stomach in this series was 61.6 years.

The physicians call attention to the fact that of the 411 cases, 88.8 per cent occurred after 50 years of age.

What about the relation of cancer to noncancer conditions? The noncancer cases were about 50 per cent of the cancer cases.

What about the symptoms of cancer in this group of 411 cases? These cases were analyzed at the first time the patients attended the Clinic. The commonest symptoms first noted by the patient were pain in the stomach, lack of appetite, and weight loss. I believe that most physicians, including this Saskatchewan group, will agree that these three symptoms occur most often in cancer of the stomach and begin with slight pain in the stomach, loss of appetite and consequent loss of weight. The pain was more definite than a vague sense of all discomfort so often reported by other stomach specialists and amounted to a real soreness or ache, not just a vague distress.

The surprising point about these symptoms was their mildness. Thus a long-standing history of ulcer of the stomach was present in only 9 per cent of the cases, and bleeding was present in only 7 cases before the first examination.

Another point observed by these research workers was that cancer patients in this series did not object to eating meat. Other research physicians have reported cancer cases who would not eat meat.

As with other research physicians, this group found that delay in reporting to their physician was the biggest factor in allowing cancer of the stomach to make such great headway.
