Money For Short-Term Loans Said To Be On The Increase

OTTAWA (CP)—The supply of money for short-term lending appears to be on the increase.
The Bank of Canada interest rate dropped sharply this week and financial sources said this is a reflection of the increased supply of short-term investment funds.
The rate charged by the Central Bank on loans to chartered banks and other lending institutions dipped to 2.91 per cent from 3.11.
This contrasts sharply with the all-time high of 4.33 per cent last Aug. 22 during a "tight-money" period. The rate this week was the lowest since April 4, 1956, when it was 2.75 per cent. Record low of 1 1/2 per cent was established in 1955.
The bank interest rate is fixed at one-quarter of one per cent above the week's average yield of the government's 90-day treasury bills.
Mounting demand for these short-term securities shoved the average yield on treasury bills down to 2.66 per cent from 2.86 a week earlier.
Heavy bidding on the treasury bills may indicate some banks and investment houses have idle funds on their hands, informants said.
The Central Bank can influence changes in the country's money supply. It buys and sells government bonds. It can bid for the treasury bills, thus increasing competition and influencing the average yield.
When the Progressive Conservatives came to power last June they embarked on a program to reverse the tight-money policy of the former Liberal government.
Since then the Bank of Canada rate has decreased from its mid-summer record high of 4.33 per cent. Meanwhile, the chartered banks' prime rate on loans dropped from 5 1/2 per cent last August to 3 1/2 per cent last month.
The United States also appears to be paring rates downwards in a return to an "easy-money" pol-

Suggests Cure For Recession

Suggests Cure For Recession
NEW YORK (AP) — United Steelworkers president David J. McDonald Monday night asked industry to fight recession "not by raising prices and cutting production but by cutting prices and increasing production."
He told the Economic Club of New York:
"Although steel prices had already been raised 13.50 a ton in less than one year, they were hiked 6 more only last July. Actually, prices could have been cut by \$6 and profits still would have compared favorably with profits earned by the industry in most prior years."
As for organized labor, McDonald said:
"We ask no preferential treatment. There will be no pressures to frustrate sensible automation."
Forecasts Sees Mild Weather
TORONTO (CP) — The United States weather bureau's 30-day forecast predicts generally mild weather for Canada this month.
The outlook for most of Eastern Canada was above normal with especially warm temperatures predicted for part of Northern Quebec.
Average temperatures for this period are Montreal 26 and Halifax 30.
