## Have Hypnotic Killer Theory

**EASTBOURNE, England (AP)**—Police are investigating a theory that a "hypnotic killer" may have been operating in this Victorian seaside resort as they began inquiries into the deaths of nearly 300 well-to-do ladies during the last 20 years. The theory was reported to Scotland Yard after rumors about several sudden deaths swept Eastbourne and aroused suspicion of a huge legacy swindle. Detective Superintendent Her-ert Hannam of the murder squad has been put in charge of the investigation. British newspapers say some of the women—mostly elderly widows and spinsters—were believed to have fallen under the "spell" of a man with hypnotic powers who used his influence in such a way that close friends and relatives never suspected him. As a starting point, police are looking into the cause of death of some 300 women and examining their wills to see who benefited. The process is expected to take many weeks and eventually produce a death pattern among some 12 to 20 women on which police will concentrate.
