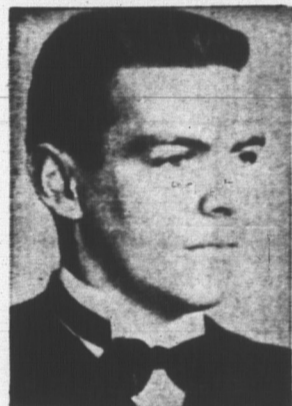

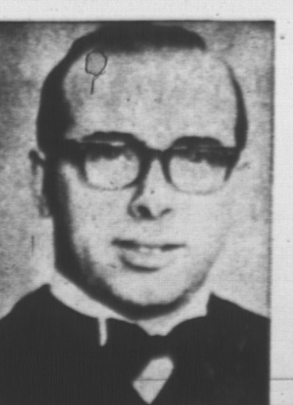

PWC Convocation Moved To Confederation Centre

At the Confederation Centre Theatre on May 21 at three o'clock, Lieutenant-Governor W. J. 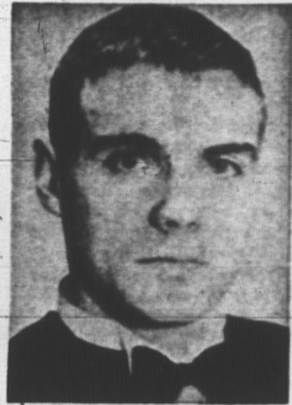

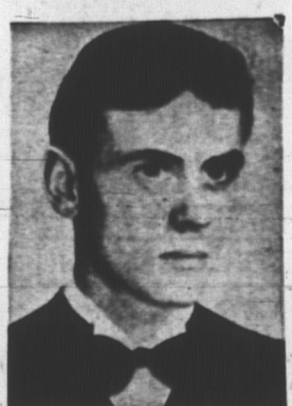
