Remember that you are never so self-sufficient that you have no room in your life for anyone else. So let's all get together and make these years the best years. **PEACE!**

We wish to announce that a Motor Sport Club has been formed on the University of Prince Edward Island campus.

The club is open to all members of the University. The purpose of the club is to offer these members the chance to participate in a student activity in order to learn about and drive any motor vehicle they wish to use.

The first function of the Motor Sport Club is going to occur this Saturday, October 30, 1971. This event is called the

HALLOWEEN SCAVENGER RALLY

It is open to all members of the University and all other people throughout P.E.I. who are sponsored by a member of the University.

The essential equipment required in this event is, of course, a car, driver and navigator. The cost of entry into the rally will be \$2.50. The event itself will consist of approx. 100 miles of road driving (all paved) in P.E.I. The essential tasks are to maintain an average speed (if possible), acquire the necessary information ie. number of a certain fire hydrant in Cornwall, and to arrive back at the University. As this rally is not a speed event there will be a maximum and minimum time limit which will not allow the driver to exceed the speed limit posted on the various roads. If the driver does not arrive at a checkpoint at the proper time there will be points deducted from his or her total score and this could probably mean losing the rally.

All in all the rally should be a fun event which will give newcomers an idea of how, why and where events will be run on the Island.
