While the residents of the country live in the midst of nature's adornments, they should not permit these to repress the cultivation of those things that minister to our higher life.

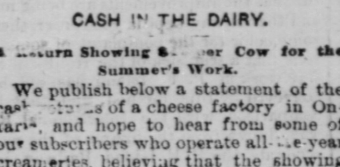
