Contract Bridge

HOW WOULD YOU BID IT?

Certain well-known experts are still arguing over the best contract in the following hand, which came up in a team-of-four contest.

South dealer.
 Both sides vulnerable.

♠ K Q 10 9
 ♥ 4 3
 ♦ 7 5 4 2
 ♣ 8 3 2

This was the auction at Table 1:
 South West North East
 1 ♠ Pass 1 ♠ Pass
 2 NT Pass 2 NT Pass

West led the heart ten, and East encouraged with the eight. South won and led a spade. West ducked, and dummy's queen of course held; but when declarer returned to his own hand for another spade lead, West put up the ace—and dummy was then "dead." The outcome was a one-trick defeat of the contract.

At the other table South reached five diamonds via this sequence:

South West North East
 1 ♠ Pass 1 ♠ Pass
 2 ♠ Pass 4 ♠ Pass
 5 ♦ Pass Pass Pass

Here also, West led the heart ten. South won, drew two rounds of trumps, then led a spade. West played low and the queen held. Now South returned to his hand with a heart and led his last spade. West realized that if he put up the ace, dummy's king and ten would both be good, since East's marked jack would obviously fall; so, hoping that South would think East had the ace and had held it up, West again ducked without hesitation. This was imaginative defense, but South was not to be misled. He went right up with the spade king, then ruffed the spade six. Now he ruffed his own heart five in dummy—and made West win a spade trick by leading the ten and discarding a club on it. West had the choice of leading clubs and establishing South's king, or, by leading another heart, giving South the chance to ruff in dummy while he got rid of a second club.
