Holman Feeder at 153 North River Road in Charlottetown (maximum numbers seen at any one time during February and March; species seen daily are starred \* ) - 1 Sharp-shinned Hawk on Mar. 2; 4 Rock Dove; 2 Downy Woodpecker\*; 1 Blue Jay; 3 Common Crow\*; 2 Black-capped Chickadee\*; 15 to 20 Common Starling\*; 5 to 10 House Sparrow\*; 1 Brown-headed Cowbird on Feb. 9; 70 to 80 Evening Grosbeak\* on Feb. 28; 2 Pine Siskin Feb. 9 and 10; 40 to 50 American Goldfinch\* on Feb. 10; 2 Song Sparrow\*. (Reported by Geoff Hogan).

Keaveny Feeder at York Point (maximum numbers seen during February; species seen daily are starred \* ) - 1 Hairy Woodpecker (seen only a few times); 2 Downy Woodpecker\*; about 10 Black-capped Chickadee\*; 1 Boreal Chickadee (seen only a few times); 14 Blue Jay\*; 40 to 50 House Sparrow (Reported by Geoff Hogan).

Wright Feeder at Head of Montague (maximum number during February and March) - 7 Blue Jay (10 after Mar. 3); Common Raven observed courting; 2 Black-capped Chickadee; Common Starling, a few occasionally; 1 House Sparrow; 5 Dark-eyed Junco. (Reported by John Wright).
