U.S. People Are Wonderful In View Of Cuban Refugees

Despite language difficulties and some setbacks in obtaining Employment, Cuban refugees moved from Miami for resettlement in other parts of the United States seem generally to be thriving and happy.

"Muy contento" — very content—said Juan Casiano, now at work in Chicago.

In Cleveland, John Izquierdo kissed his fingertips and exclaimed in halting English "These people! They are wonderful!"

His reference was to members of the Church of the Good Shepherd, one of a number of Cleveland area churches which "adopted" Cuban refugee families.

Izquierdo, his wife Julia and their six-year-old son Juan were among 25 families flown from

It was the fourth flight carrying Cubans from Miami to homes and jobs in other U.S. cities. The Cleveland project did not get off to an auspicious start, but the situation improved as time went on.

Even before the refugee plane took off from Miami, Cleveland Mayor Anthony Celebrezze expressed opposition to the move. He said he felt that any available jobs should go first to unemployed residents of the city.

Even worse for the Cubans was the icy February weather which made many of them ill. Three families left to live with relatives or friends on the east coast.

Eighty-seven Cuban exiles reached New Jersey this week.

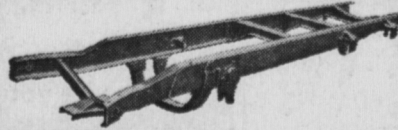

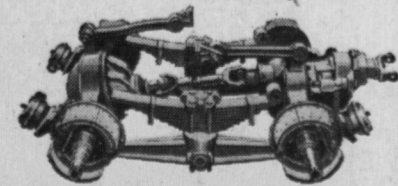

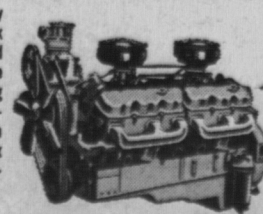
