## Development To Hinge On Fishing Study

"If there is to be a development of fisheries, we naturally suppose that it will apply to all the Atlantic Provinces," Premier Walter R. Shaw said Wednesday.

He was commenting on the fisheries department's study of

all aspects of the industry in the province.

"Today by Fisheries Minister Leo Rostler. When the study is finished, according to Mr. Rostler, a proposal will be made to the federal government for assistance in expanding fisheries.

Recently, the Newfoundland government proposed that the federal government share in that province's fisheries development in the amount of \$50,000,000.

Premier Shaw suggested that with large funds expected to be available for the Atlantic Development Board to work with, there should be consideration of development of fisheries.

"This," he said, "could come under recommendations of the board, and for that reason our whole industry is being given careful study to determine what general assistance could be provided to promote greater expansion."

## Shaw Is Doubtful 2-Minister Plan

Premier Walter R. Shaw said Thursday he was "a bit doubtful" of how successful the appointment of two ministers of agriculture for Canada may be.

He was commenting on statements regarding farming made yesterday in Ottawa by John Mullanly, MP-Kings.

to provide capital for island farmers to expand their holdings.

Premier Shaw said "I would like to point out that we are progressing very rapidly in this province as a result of the establishment and expansion of processing plants for farm products, and the development of the tobacco industry is providing a substantial solution to the problems of the small farm."

"Possibly too much emphasis has been placed on the large farm holding to the exclusion of the small holding. New co-ops and new outlets can be of great advantage to the small farmer."

"DEFINITELY INCORRECT"

Regarding Mr. Mullanly's statement that little has been done in the province under the agricultural rehabilitation and development program, Premier Shaw said "This is definitely incorrect."

"Rapid progress has been made in applying the provisions of ARDA, and if Mr. Mullanly had cared to confer with the ARDA administration in Ottawa before making statements of this kind, he would have found that this province is possibly leading all provinces in a resources development program and an application of the ARDA program.

"Research is going on continually into the problems of farm and resource development."

"The first leadership course now ending in the province have been of great assistance in clarifying the ARDA program, as well as the whole intention behind resources development."
