Dear Mr. Becker: Your recent dream hand reminds me of the time I was playing in a team of four and came to the final board with our team having been 2,000 points behind at the half-way mark of a 36-board match. I knew something desperate had to be done, so when East opened with two spades I overcalled with five hearts! This may strike you as an odd bid to make, especially considering the vulnerability, but since the match looked lost anyway I didn't care too much if anything catastrophic took place. Naturally, when East doubled my partner's six bid, I redoubled—what else could I do?
