This column shall also provide regular information on any special upcoming SU events such as general meetings, constitutional changes, etc.

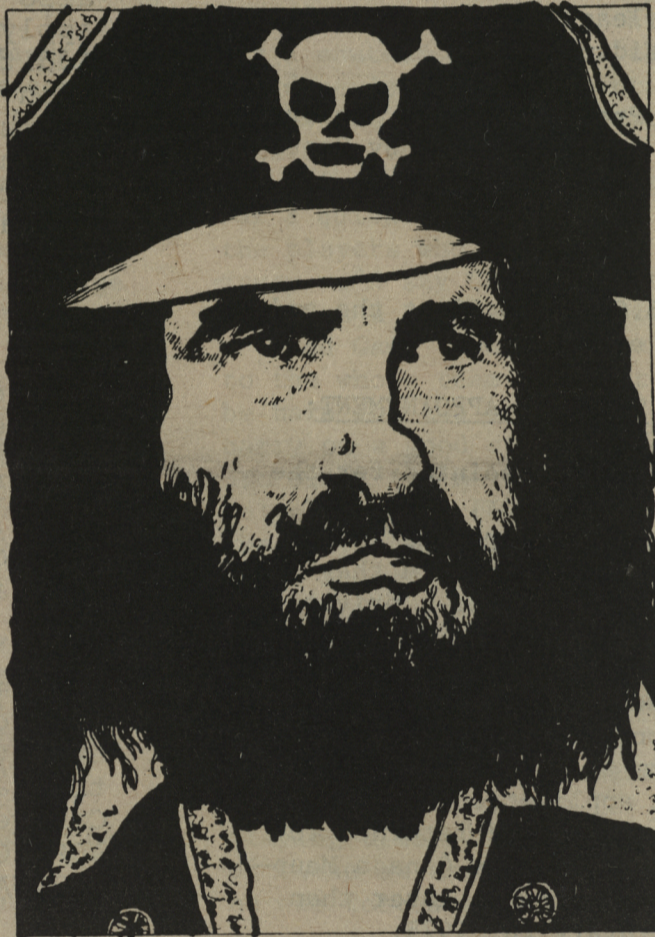

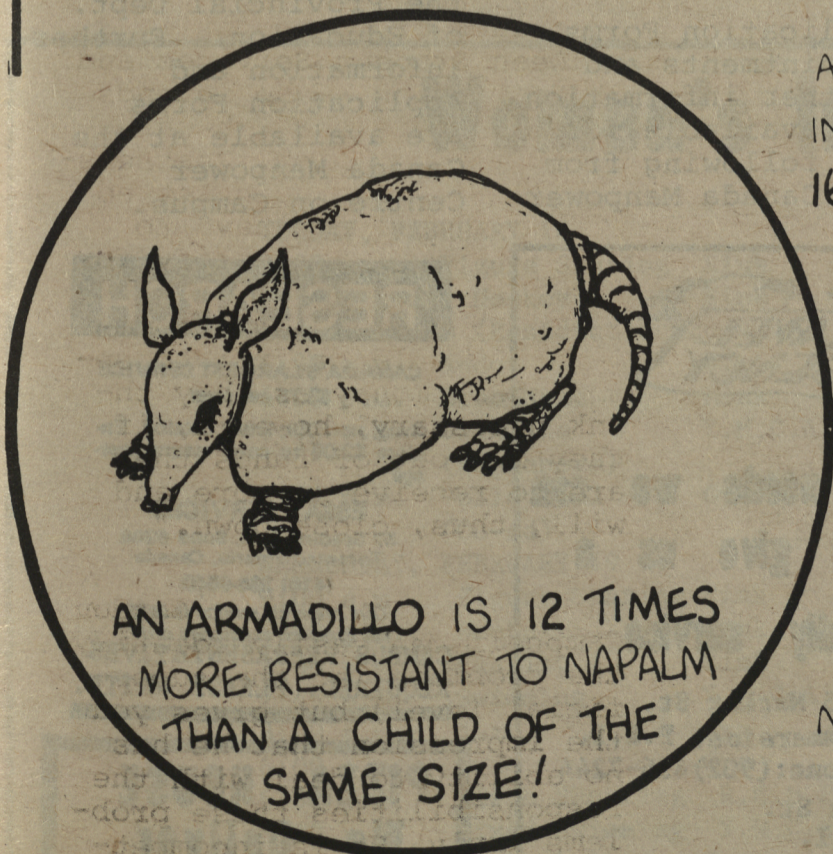
