

# Clark Captures Grand Prix

ZANDVOORT (AP) — World champion Jim Clark of Scotland driving his Lotus racer, flashed to a convincing win in the Dutch Grand Prix here Sunday.

The 27-year-old Scot was the top of the 1964 world championship ratings, joining his rival and friend Graham Hill, the British BRM driver who won the first race of the series at Zandvoort last month.

Both Clark and Hill now have 12 points.

Second in Sunday's classic race was the Italian Ferrari driver John Surtees of Britain in a new V8 machine, appearing in its first full championship race.

Third man home was second Lotus-works driver Peter Arundell.

Fourth was Hill, whose BRM was plagued with fuel injection trouble.

It was the second straight year that Clark had won this race over 80 laps of the 2.62 mile Zandvoort circuit.

Clark's race time was two hours, seven minutes and 35.4 seconds—an average speed of 80 miles an hour. On his way to victory he set a circuit record of 101.4 miles an hour, topping his own previous mark of 106.6 miles an hour set last year.

# Canadian Dealer Buys Scoundrel

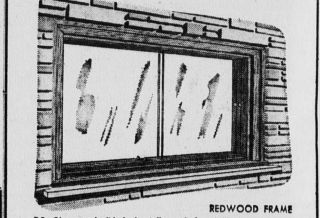

P.E. Glass panels slide horizontally on vinyl track "Redwood" frame.

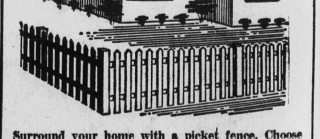
