## N. S. Soldier

Drowned At Suez

OTTAWA (CP)—The body of a Canadian serving with UN forces in Egypt has been recovered from the Suez Canal, army headquarters said Wednesday.

Corporal John Thomas Roberts, 22, of Albro Lake, near Halifax, was missed from the Canadian contingent of the UNEF June 9. An autopsy on the body showed death was due to drowning. There was no evidence of foul play.

He was last seen the night of June 9 while a motor convoy was stopped overnight on a trip from Rafah to Sharm el Shiekh. Egyptian authorities found the body Saturday and identified him from metal identification discs and papers found on his person.

The army said Roberts is believed to have strayed accidentally over an unprotected, 10-foot-high canal bank in the darkness and fallen into swiftly-flowing water. Although a strong swimmer, the army said, the weight of his clothing and the strong current probably prevented him from reaching shore.

He was buried with full military honors two days ago in the Imperial War Graves Commission Cemetery at Moascar, Egypt.

His widow lives at Albro Lake.

With its wings water-soaked, the eagle swam to shore where the boys easily captured it.
