

Grandson Of CPR Builder Dies In London

LONDON (CP) — Donald Sterling Palmer Howard, third Baron Strathcona and Mount Royal and grandson of a Canadian pioneer, died Sunday at 67.

His grandfather, Donald Smith, spent much of his life in Canada where he played a leading part in the construction of the Canadian Pacific Railway. He became the first Lord Strathcona and died in 1914.

Lord Strathcona, a graduate of Cambridge University, was Conservative member of Parliament for North Cumberland from 1922 to 1926. The next year he became Deputy chairman of the Conservative party and in 1928 he was appointed a member of the Indian statutory commission.

He was made undersecretary of state for war in 1934 and resigned in 1938 after criticizing several cabinet members for the state of Britain's defences.

The barony goes to his eldest son, Donald Howard, 35.
