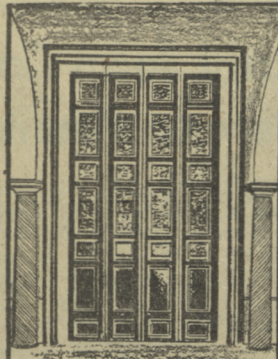

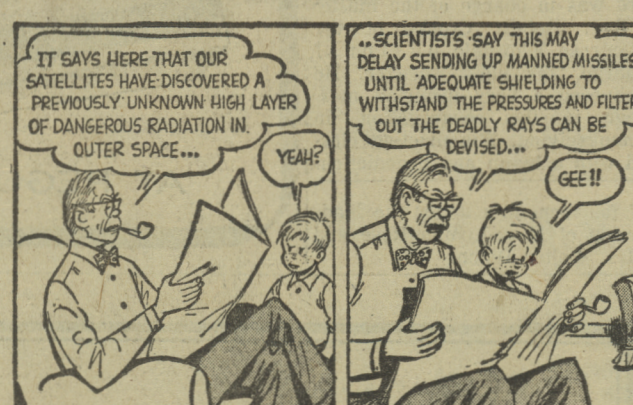
Russia Offers Loan To UAR To Build Dam On Nile River

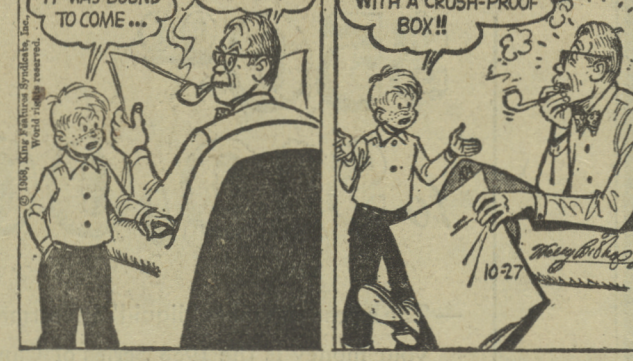
Gas Pipeline Now Can Supply Customers Along Full Route
