Ants In Peace And War

We may think of New York or London as great cities of activity, which indeed they are, yet with all their hustle and bustle, neither can boast the activity that goes on in an ant city. Here the wheels of industry never cease to turn, for there are neither Sunday's nor holidays in the ant kingdom.

The Queen Ant is by far the most important insect in the colony, being the mother of almost the entire population. She is capable of laying eggs, some of which develop into sexless workers, while others produce future queens and drones.

Some species spin a cocoon around the grub in which it rests inert and foodless until nature opens the tiny prison to release a perfect ant. This transformation period is one of the marvels of the insect world.

Now that the baby ant has entered a new and strange world, it still must be fed and cared for by its elders, in much the same way as humans must care for tiny tots. Just as soon as they are old enough to catch on, they are taught to do all kinds of useful tasks such as building, nursing and what have you.

Every colony has its quota of feeble old drones, many of them not sufficiently strong to feed themselves. Nothing is done about these star-boarders until swarming day comes around. Then they are forced out-of-doors where, in their feeble condition, they soon fall prey to birds and other insects.

When they settle down in their new surroundings, they break off their wings as they never will have any use for them again. The swarming day saw their first and last flight.

It so happens that occasionally a colony must leave its city to seek a new home and when the time for the exodus draws near, there is a great excitement in every part of the colony.

Once the ants begin their march and a well-ordered march it is—a host of other insects follow. These are not prisoners, but are special guests of the ant family, or in some cases, pets. Every colony has its guest insects which are fed and cared for gratis, that is, all but the ophidids which supply a sort of milk for the ants called honeydew.

Where do they get them? The eggs are collected from living plants and carried to their underground nurseries where they are carefully stored until spring. Then they are incubated and carried back to the same plants from which they were taken.

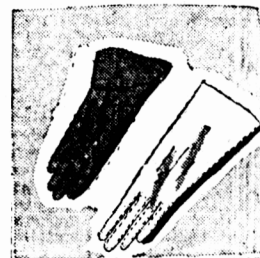

Ship Afire 330 Miles From Bermuda

NEW YORK, May 8—(AP)—An American cargo ship loaded with cotton was afire tonight 330 miles northwest of Bermuda, but the blaze apparently was under control. The United States Coast Guard said a message from the S. S. Joseph Lykes, several hours after her initial call for help, reported the fire "under control for the time being."

The Coast Guard believed there was no immediate danger to the freighter's crew. The 6,829-ton vessel, owned by the Lykes Brothers Steamship Company, radioed that fire had broken out in her No. 3 hold. She reported she was returning to Hampton Roads, Va.

The Coast Guard sent the cutter Humbolt to her aid from a weather station about 180 miles southwest of the vessel. The cutter was expected to meet the burning ship about 11 p.m. EDT. The Lykes sent out a call to all

ships in the vicinity to indicate their positions.

Would Have Britain Seize Soviet Ship

LONDON, May 8—(Reuters)—Martin Lindsay, Conservative, suggested today in the House of Commons that Britain should seize a Soviet ship in a British port in retaliation for the arrest of the British trawler Etruria by a Soviet gunboat in the White Sea last Monday. Ernest Davies, Undersec-

retary for Foreign Affairs, replied that the Government has to behave with responsibility in such matters. He added that Sir David Kelly, British Ambassador in Moscow, delivered a British note of inquiry to the Soviet authorities Friday and that it is reasonable to allow time for a reply to be received.
