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Simpsons Have Increased Profit

TORONTO, (CP) - Simpsons, Ltd., had net profit in the year ended Jan. 7 of \$5,775,992, compared with \$3,014,941 in the preceding year.

After payment of preferred dividends, these earnings, which included earnings from the mail order business which since has been sold to Simpsons-Sears, Ltd., were equivalent to \$1.60 a share on the 3,000,000 shares now outstanding, compared to 70 cents for the previous year, on the basis of the present common share capitalization.

Sale of the Simpsons, Ltd., mail order, agency and order-office business to Simpsons-Sears, Ltd., a new company in which Simpsons, Ltd., has an equal share with Sears, Roebuck and Company, went into effect at the opening of business Jan. 8, the first day of the new fiscal year, and resulted in a net profit over book values of \$6,862,188.

Higher were Montgomery Ward, J. Case, Lockheed, Philco, Commonwealth Edison and Dow Chemical.

Lower were Goodyear, Sears Roebuck, Caterpillar Tractor and American Smelting.

Canadian stocks showed little change. International Nickel, Hiram Walker and Distillers Seagram each gained 1-8.

McIntyre lost 1-2; Canadian Pacific and Dome Mines were unchanged.

On the American stock exchange Lake Shore, Giant Yellowknife and Royalite Oil were unchanged.
