**Which gifts to storage?**

If a young couple plan to live in a small apartment an important thing for the bride to consider is which of her wedding gifts she will be able to use immediately, and which will have to be stored. The sign of an efficient homemaker is to plan early for storage of these gifts which she cannot use right away. It is best to begin cataloguing your gifts as soon as they arrive, visualizing which ones will be in immediate use. These which have to be stored

should be handled wisely — as soon as they are received. Packing materials should be kept to be used again. After display, single gifts should be repacked in their proper containers.

When receiving a set of gifts such as glassware, check each to ascertain there is no breakage, and repack all but one, using the leftover piece for display.

Professional warehouses are ideal for storing gifts over an extended period of time. However, many newlyweds are able to find storage space in their family homes. Try to find a place of uniform and low dining temperature and remember to protect gifts from dust and air.

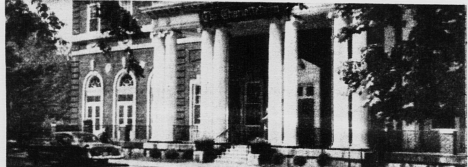
