A By-Law for Levying and Specifying the Rate of Assessment on Real Estate and Personal Property in the City of Charlottetown for General Civic Purposes, under Statute 51 Victoria, Chapter 12.

BE it enacted by the City Council of the City of Charlottetown as follows:
1st. The rate of assessment on Real Estate for general civic purposes, under Statute, for the year commencing the 1st day of January, A. D. 1892, and ending the 31st day of December, A. D. 1892, is hereby specified and fixed at the rate of ONE PER CENT on every dollar of the value of Real Estate as assessed by the Assessors of the said City.

A By-Law for allowing a Rate of Discount on the Assessments on Real Estate and Personal Property in the City of Charlottetown for General Civic Purposes, for the current year ending the 31st day of December, A. D. 1892.

BE it enacted by the City Council of the City of Charlottetown as follows:
1st. A Discount at the rate of TWO AND ONE HALF PER CENTUM shall be allowed to all Taxpayers who shall, on or before the Fifteenth day of July next, A. D. 1892, pay to the City Clerk, at his office, the taxes severally due by them for the current year on Real Estate and Personal Property for Civic purposes.

BE it enacted by the City Council of the City of Charlottetown as follows:
1st. A Discount at the rate of TWO AND ONE HALF PER CENTUM shall be allowed to all Taxpayers who shall, on or before the Fifteenth day of July next, A. D. 1892, pay to the City Clerk, at his office, the taxes severally due by them for the current year on Real Estate and Personal Property for Civic purposes.
