

Esquires' Jackie Parker Goes On Bock At Own Request

EDMONTON (CP)—Edmonton Esquires of the Western Football Conference announced Wednesday that star quarterback, Parker will be traded or sold to another Canadian club at his own request.

Hastings (Red) McMahon, president of the club, said Parker told the Esquires he was not prepared to sign a new contract and if necessary will play out his option with the club.

McMahon said a month of negotiation has proved fruitless. Money, he said, was not the paramount issue.

A club statement issued at a press conference, said Parker feels "he and the football club would be better off if he played elsewhere."

Parker, 31-year-old triple-threat quarterback, has been with Edmonton since 1954. The native of Knoxville, Tenn., would be eligible for Canadian citizenship in the spring.

WANTS BETTER CHANCE

Parker said a new club would be able to provide better opportunities in the future. He said he had been thinking of asking the club to let him go since the end of last season.

McMahon said the club has notified other Canadian teams that Parker is available.

Parker said he would not necessarily accept any trade arrangement made by the Esquires.

Although he preferred any city, Parker said he thought Toronto would offer the best possibilities. He said he

had not requested a trade with any specific club.

ARGON INTERESTED

In Toronto, Lew Hayman, managing director of Toronto Argonauts, said his Eastern Football Conference would be "interested" in getting Parker—but it would depend on what the Esquires would want in money, in players, or in both.

Parker has scored more points—76—and more touchdowns—79—in league play than any player in Canadian football history.

Parker's list of football honors and records are numerous.

In his rookie year he won the first of eight consecutive all-star rankings and was the Western Conference's most valuable player, an honor he has won seven times.

He played key roles in Esquires' Grey Cup victories in 1954, 1955 and 1956.

Three times Parker was named Canada's outstanding

football player and he was runner-up three years.

Twice he has led the Western Conference in scoring. In six seasons he has averaged 6 yards on 74 carries, completed 63 per cent of 1,844 pass attempts for 11,337 yards and 103 touchdowns and caught 103 of 123 passes himself for 1,915 yards and 16 touchdowns.
