Contract Bridge

A WEIRD CONTRACT

A double-dummy problem is not really bridge, and for that reason, few such "puzzles" are included in this column. There have been several requests, however, for an explanation of a statement in Culbertson books that a small slam can be made under certain conditions when declarer has only two trumps, with only two more in dummy—so here is proof of that statement. It is sincerely hoped, however, that no reader will assume that this column encourages the bidding of small slams (or other contracts with) such holdings!

Please do not ask how South could actually reach six spades in a serious rubber or duplicate game! (Perhaps he meant to cuebid the spade suit, and before he knew it, he was in six; then he forgot to take himself out to six notrump!) This is not a serious hand—the idea is merely to show the possibilities.

So, we're assuming that the contract is six spades by South. West could be "mean" and open a trump—but let's suppose further that he prefers to open the club queen. Can South fulfill the contract? Yes—as follows:

The club ace wins, and South also cashes the club king, then the three top cards in diamonds and in hearts. South discards a club on the third heart; dummy discards a club on the third diamond. Meanwhile, the defenders have had to follow suit. Now dummy leads a heart and South ruffs; the bidding of small slams (or any South leads a diamond and dummy ruffs (with the ten or the queen, as may be needed). South ruffs the last heart with his second and last trump; dummy ruffs the last diamond with his second and last trump. The defenders have been undertrumping helplessly right along. South has his 12 tricks, and the thirteenth trick, the losing club, is taken by both opponents, in effect!
