#### INFECTED CATTLE KILLED.

#### An Early Meeting of Parliament.

OTTAWA, Nov. 9.—McMillan, M. P., will press his bill next session for the appointment of a Civil Service Supervision Board to make appointments, dismissals, etc.

A petition for the release of Grenier who libelled Hon. Mr. Tarte has been received by the Government. It contains the signatures of over a thousand people.

Fourteen of the cattle affected with tuberculosis at the experimental farm have been killed.

It is stated that the meeting of Parliament will take place earlier than was anticipated. It may actually be convened towards the end of January—either the 20th or 27th.

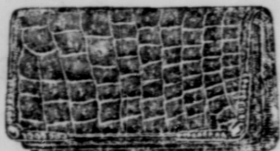
#### Fearful that Spain Cannot Establish Autonomous Government.

## UNITED STATES AND CANADA

### Proposed Settlement of All Difficulties.

#### Sir Wilfrid and Sir Louis to do the Business.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 9.—The authorities here have been advised that the arrival of Sir Wilfrid Laurier, Sir Louis Davies and other officials of the Dominion is to have an important bearing not only on the Behring Sea settlement but on all pending questions which have been the sources of international complication between the United States and Canada.

### TRANSFERENCE AND DISMISSAL.

#### An Official Forced to Walk the Plank.

MONCTON, Nov. 9.—Percy Foster, a guard at Dorchester Penitentiary, has been transferred to St. Vincent de Paul, Montreal, and his place filled by a man from Quebec. William Welsh, wharfinger at Cape Tormentine, has been dismissed and Ephraim Aallen appointed in his place. Political partizanship is alleged as the cause.

### LATEST NEWS BY WIRE AND MAIL.

WINNIPEG, Man., Nov. 6 — Private Liverpool cables received in Minneapolis say that No. 1 Northern Duluth wheat arriving there consigned to and owned by millers, is unsatisfactory and is being replaced with No. 1 hard Manitoba and the No. 1 Northern sold to speculators for deliveries on contracts.

QUEBEC, Nov. 6.—A certified captain of this city, supported by the Royal Society of Canada, will organize an expedition to the North Pole next spring. He is working entirely different from any other explorers who have tried to reach that point, but he will first apply to both local and federal governments for assistance towards bringing his scheme to a practical end. He proposes, if aided by the government, to use one of their cruisers as far north as possible, when he will disembark a skiff which he has arranged to go over the ice and up hills with the assistance of his seven men who will compose the party. He has already chosen some of his men, but in a few days he will make a public call so that he may have broader opportunities for choosing those adapted for the journey. The medical examination, which all will have to pass through, is very strict.

NEW YORK, Nov. 6.—A despatch to the World from Washington says: "General Nelson A. Miles was asked last night to give his reasons for recommending the fortification of the new federal building in Chicago with gatling guns. He said: There are nine places in this country where the treasure chests of Uncle Sam are located and for the past 20 years I have urged the necessity of protecting these depositories with the most approved pattern of fire arms. While I was in Constantinople, the details of the attack on the Turkish bank in that city were related to me, and brought back to me the necessity for some means of defence for the public institutions of the United States.
